The post of Chairman BBU has become vacant and that of World Cup Team Manager may shortly also become vacant. Applications are welcome from suitable candidates and these should be of no more than a one A4 page CV, plus a maximum of 250 words as to why you think you would be suitable for the position(s) and, in particular your vision to improve the standing and in particular results of British Biathlon.

Please note that the BBU neither owns nor rents any office space. Candidates would be expected to work from home or an existing office. Candidates must be able to demonstrate an ability to communicate in English (written & oral). Both posts are particularly suitable for the self-employed or retired.

The vacancies are for:

Chairman (Non-Executive Director).

After 5 years as Chairman, André Oszmann has retired and we wish to fill the vacancy by the end of September. Candidates must be British and should preferably live in or work "near" London to easily liaise with the BOA, UK Sport etc. A commercial / legal / professional background and knowledge of sponsorship matters would be desirable, as well as an interest in sport (not necessarily Biathlon). A cumulative commitment of 1 - 2 days per month, which includes 3 or 4 BOA / UKS meetings, plus attendance at 3 or 4 Board meetings (one in Germany) is expected annually. The post is unpaid but normal expenses will be met.

World Cup Team Manager.

The seasonal post of World Cup Team Manager is likely to become vacant in October. The Manager will be "on the circuit" for approx 3 weeks in every 4 from mid-November to mid-March. The Manager supports the World Cup athletes by assisting with their daily travel, logistic, training, ski testing and other needs as well as "scoping" on the range. The Manager need not be British nor live in the UK but must hold a driving licence. The Manager is a member of the BBU Selection Committee; will liaise with the IBU Cup Team Manager on a regular basis; should have a detailed knowledge of IBU Rules; reports to the SD for sporting matters and to the Sec Gen for administrative and financial matters. Spoken German is an advantage. The Manager will be paid expenses and, if a civilian, receive an honorarium of approx EUR 100.00 per day whilst "on the circuit".

Future Director Vacancies:

Secretary General (CEO), Sport (Performance) Director, Finance Director.

The current Secretary General (CEO) and the Sport Director are both expected to stay in post until after the Olympic Winter Games in 2018. It is also proposed to appoint a Finance Director by 2018.
